To cater to these enhancements, the school timings will be changed to 8:00 a.m. to 2:15 p.m. from May 01, 2024. We aim to optimize our students' engagement and participation in extracurricular activities while ensuring a balanced schedule throughout the week.

Motive behind the enhancements: > MONDAY TEST:

Monday test provides regular opportunities for students to assess their understanding of the material covered in class, identify areas of strength and weakness, and reinforce learning through consistent practice.

> CLASS ASSEMBLIES:

Class assemblies are one of the best platforms to inculcate various skills, including public speaking, creativity, leadership, and appreciation for diversity among students.

> SUPW:

Saturday Clubs previously held on Saturdays will now take place on Wednesdays/Thursdays as part of the SUPW (Socially Useful Productive Work).

This change aims to optimize our students' engagement and participation in extracurricular activities while ensuring a balanced schedule throughout the week. Shifting clubs to weekdays will ensure 100% execution, as Saturdays often saw disruptions due to various reasons.

> ZERO PERIOD:

Zero period will be utilized for preparing Sports & Performing Arts school teams for various competitions/in-house events, and assisting students in preparing for competitive exams such as SOF, VVM, etc.

The initial selection of team will be based on previous performance of students in various areas eventually resulting in training them. In addition, we believe that students coming from far-off distances will have a better opportunity to participate, as these will be part of regular school hours.

> WEDNESDAY/THURSDAY ACTIVITIES:

A block period for both scholastic and co-scholastic activities will contribute to the comprehensive development of students. Combination of these activities will create a balanced and enriching learning environment that prepares students for success in academics, career, and life.

> SATURDAY SPORTS:

Saturday sports in addition to the regular H&PE slots will offer children a diverse range of games tailored to their preferences, enabling them to refine their skills and potentially earn selection onto school teams based on their performance.
