Participation is **optional**, and students are requested to carefully read the itineraries of both trips and **select only one** based on their interest and preference.

## 1. Chennai-Sriharikota-Pondicherry (Open to students of Grades VI to X)

This enriching educational tour combines science, culture, and history. A visit to ISRO – Sriharikota will offer students firsthand insight into India's remarkable space research and satellite launch capabilities. The itinerary also includes exploration of the cultural vibrance of Chennai and the colonial charm of Pondicherry, making it both informative and memorable.

# 2. Delhi (Open to students of Grade VIII to X)

The objective of the trip is to provide students with experiential learning beyond the classroom through cultural immersion, scientific exploration, and outdoor adventure. It aims to develop life skills, foster curiosity, and nurture team spirit through a balanced mix of fun, heritage, and hands-on activities.

- **Estimated Cost : Rs. 40000 per student.** (Inclusive of all meals, stay, transport and tickets of various venues)

- Dates: Last week of September or the first week of October

## Departure Day: Ferozepur - Delhi

- Assemble at school
- Depart for Delhi by AC coach (overnight journey)

## Day 1: Delhi - Chennai (Flight)

- Early morning flight from Delhi to Chennai
- Check-in and lunch at hotel
- Visit Guindy National Park, St. Thomas Cathedral, Marina Beach
- Dinner & overnight stay in Chennai

## Day 2: Chennai - Sriharikota (ISRO Visit)

- Visit Satish Dhawan Space Centre, learn about rocket launches and satellite missions
- Lunch at Sriharikota, return to Chennai
- Dinner & overnight stay in Chennai

## Day 3: Chennai - Mahabalipuram - Pondicherry

- Visit Mahabalipuram: Shore Temple, Five Rathas, Krishna's Butter Ball
- Proceed to Pondicherry
- Explore French Colony, Promenade Beach, Gandhi Statue
- Dinner & overnight stay in Pondicherry

# Day 4: Pondicherry - Chennai - Delhi (Flight)

- Visit Sri Aurobindo Ashram & Auroville Paper Factory
- Post lunch, return to Chennai
- Flight to Delhi, overnight coach journey to Firozpur

## Day 5: Arrival at School

- ➤ Destination: Delhi (Open to students of Grades VIII to X)
- Partners: GB International
- Estimated Cost: Rs. 13000 per student. (Inclusive of all meals, stay, transport and tickets of various venues)
- Dates: Last week of September or the first week of October
- Itinerary

#### Day-1

- Early morning departure from school by AC coach
- Breakfast en route, check-in to hotel in Delhi
- Visits: National Science Museum, India Gate, Rashtrapati Bhavan, Parliament House, Kartavya Path (from outside)
- Dinner & overnight stay in Delhi

#### Day-2

- Full-day cultural & adventure experience
- Activities: Dhol welcome, music, dance, rope activities, puppet show, rural games, indoor games
- Lunch & evening snacks at the farm
- Return to Delhi, dinner & overnight stay

#### Day-3

- Visit Qutub Minar & Indian Air Force Museum
- Lunch, then depart for Firozpur
- Dinner en route and arrival at school

<u>Transportation and Accommodation:</u> We have made arrangements for safe and comfortable transportation and accommodations for the duration of the trip in collaboration with our partners. Details regarding travel and lodging will be shared once we have the consent from the officials of the venues.

<u>Supervision and Safety:</u> The safety and well-being of our students are paramount. The trip will be supervised by experienced teachers and by members of the partner team.
